

NEW CHURCH ORGAN.

Trinity Church Will Have a New Instrument.

The contract for a large two-manual organ for Trinity Church of this city, has been awarded to C. S. Haskell of Philadelphia. The organ will contain 26 complete registers, 11 being in the great organ, 10 in the swell organ, and 5 in the pedal organ. There will be 3 unison couplers, one sub-coupler and one super-coupler, and 7 composition pedals. A grand crescendo pedal effecting the entire organ will be attached.

The action will be electro-pneumatic, and the key-desk will be movable. Delivery is fixed for April 3. The committee having the matter in charge consists of Henry B. Thompson, Samuel C. Biddle and Joseph Swift.
