The information found in this document comes from the original contract located in the archives of Casavant Frères in Saint-Hyacinthe, Québec and from correspondence with Alan T. Jackson of Toronto.

The organ casework in this church dates to an instrument built by R. S. Williams. Prior to the installation of Casavant Opus 2622, the Williams organ was replaced by Legge. It was the Legge Choir division that was connected to Casavant Opus 2622 awaiting the installation of the prepared stops in the November 1959 contract.

Opus 2622 was destroyed in August 1976 by fire. The church replaced it with Casavant Frères Opus 3393.
