This organ was originally installed in a lower-level room of the Fine Arts Center. That room later became the weaving/loom room. In the summer of 1982, the organ was moved to the upper, left gallery of the Center for Campus Ministry where it was available for practice and was used for mid-week worship services.

This was one of the first three "Martini" Holtkamps built. It has the stopped wood 16' Gedackt in the Pedal. After the first three, this was changed in favor of a 16' Quintadena extension.

The organ was sold in the 1990s to Todd Wilson for use in his home church in Cleveland.
