NOTES

This original home of this organ is not known.

It was acquired by Jack Barr of Buffalo, NY in the early 1970's and installed in a basement billiard room of his home. When Mr. Barr passed-away in 2015, the organ was acquired by Jason Klinger of Buffalo and in his home for about 6 months before he moved to Hillsboro, Oregon. The organ was placed for sale while still in Buffalo, but ended-up being brought across the country.

It was advertised in numerous internet locations. Seen on Facebook's 'Pipe Organ Garage Sale' Jim Stettner of Puget Sound Pipe Organs recommended it to Mark and Terry Reitz of Quilcene, WA. for a home practice organ. It was examined in storage on Friday, February 24, 2017 by Michael Way of Puget Sound Pipe Organs who gave it the OK. The Reitz's purchased the organ for \$2,000.00.
