Notes ²

The information found in this document comes from the original contract located in the archives of Casavant Frères in Saint-Hyacinthe, Québec.

¹ The term "Registers" refers to the total number of speaking stops including duplexed and extended stops but excluding couplers, tremulants and controls. "Stops" refers to the total number of independent or straight stops excluding duplexed and extended stops as well as couplers and controls. The analysis is not complete because there is no indication of the number of pipes, extensions or duplexing in the console specification.

The contract for Opus 2538 was signed with John O. Morel for a new two-manual console for the L. E. Morel organ at North Broadview United Church at Broadview and Dearborn Avenue in Toronto. Alan T. Jackson & Company began to service this organ in December 1965. The contract for servicing ended in January 1967 when this congregation joined with Danforth United to become Eastminster United Church. In May 1969, Alan T. Jackson & Company moved the Morel organ with its Casavant console from the North Broadview building to St. Barnabas Anglican Church in Peterborough, Ontario where the organ stood at the back of the nave. In 1980, the St. Barnabas parish stopped servicing the organ and bought an electronic. (The information in this paragraph was provided by Alan T. Jackson-May 21, 2007)
