Notes ²

The information found in this document comes from the original contract located in the archives of Casavant Frères in Saint-Hyacinthe, Québec.

Opus 2670 was the largest of three organs commissioned by Westminster Presbyterian Church in Dayton, Ohio, all specifications bearing the date of August 9, 1960. Opus 2646, a two manual organ for the Chapel, and Opus 2647, the Gallery Organ, were installed in September 1961. The main instrument was installed in July 1962.

¹ The term "Registers" refers to the total number of speaking stops including duplexed and extended stops but excluding couplers, tremulants and controls. "Stops" refers to the total number of independent or straight stops excluding duplexed and extended stops as well as couplers and controls.
